Differentiation of tied teams

Should teams be on equal competition points at the end of the season the following will apply:

Where a full 'home and away' round robin is completed, teams will be differentiated by:

- (1) The team with the highest '*total shots for*'
- (2) The team with the greatest shots differential (shots for – shots against).
- (3) The greater '*total shots for*' from the games between those teams

Where a full home and away round is not played due to unavailability of greens or due to the number of teams in the division, as in the case of Hutt Valley Division 3, the top two teams at the end of the round robin will play off to find the Division winner and progress to the Zonal final.

In the case of teams needing to be differentiated, for example deciding 2nd/3rd in Hutt Valley Division 3, teams will be differentiated by:

- (1) The team with the highest '*total shots for*'
- (2) The team with the greatest shots differential (shots for – shots against).
- (3) The greater '*total shots for*' from the games between those teams

Closure of greens

Should a club close its green, due to weather or for another reason, the host club's Pennants Coordinator is responsible for informing the opposition club's coordinators.

Where a green is unavailable, the fixture can be transferred to another green by mutual consent. We encourage clubs, where possible, to play the games on the scheduled days to avoid any potential scheduling issues.

If the host club's Coordinator is unable to complete this function, for whatever reason, the host club remains responsible for informing the opposition prior to the scheduled start.
