

Wednesday morning WinterFours @ Naenae indoors 23 June to 11 August

Revised Conditions of Play (10 June 2021)

Club teams, any gender – any combo. Dress code is mufti.

Start time each week is 10am, 18 ends, no time limit.

The competition will run over 8 Wednesdays, starting Wednesday morning 23 June 2021 at 10am. The format will be round robin over 7 weeks with finals play-offs on Wednesday 11 August.

Cost of entry is \$50 a team.

There will be freedom of player movement between teams where a club has 2 teams.

The initial 7 weeks will be a random, round robin draw. The 8th week will be finals week with the highest rating team playing the 2nd team (Division 1), the 3rd team playing the 4th team (Division 2), 5 v. 6 (Division 3) and 7 v. 8 (Division 4).

Division 1 to 4 winners will receive a Bowls Wellington certificate, as the *WinterFours* winner for their division. Next year, dependent on the number of entries, a trophy will be provided for the Division 1 winner, engraved to include the winner for this inaugural year.

Match points for *WinterFours*:

Game win	7 points
Game draw	4 points
Game loss	0 points
Bonus	1 point

A Bonus point will be awarded for either winning by a differential of 11 or more shots or for losing by a differential of 2 or less shots.

Round robin placings

Placings will be decided by the side with the best overall **match points** from all round robin games played.

At the end of the round robin stage, should two or more sides be equal on **match points**, the side with the most **game wins** will determine the winner (or higher placed team). If still equal, the side with most **game wins and draws** will be the winner. If still equal, the side with the **best overall differential** will be the winner. Finally, if still equal, it will be determined by the **winner** of the match when the 2 sides met.

Note: Most bowlers will know that the indoor temperature at Naenae during the colder months does require bowlers to wrap up in warmer clothing.
