Dear Clubs,

As part of the ongoing evaluation of Tournaments and Competitions, Bowls Wellington invites clubs and members to make submissions for changes for the 2021-22 season.

These changes can be regarding the Conditions of Play, structure, format, scheduling or any other aspect which may improve the competitions and tournaments we deliver to our bowling community.

It is important for all submission authors to have a clear understanding of the process and requirements. Authors are encouraged to read last years Submission Summary and Minutes of the Delegates Meeting on June 22nd. These are available on the website under 'For Clubs.'

Specifically;

- A) all submissions must be made on the correct form with appropriate supporting documentation.
- B) submissions need to consider the overall impact of such proposal from all perspectives.
- C) any recurring submission which was unsuccessful last year needs to clearly demonstrate why the proposal now warrants reconsideration.

The timeline for the review is:

April 1:	Submissions open
April 23:	Submissions close
April 24:	Submissions collated, vetted and reviewed by the Review Committee
April 30:	Proposals sent to clubs for consideration
May 25:	Changes voted upon by clubs at Delegate's Meeting
May 26:	Voting goes to Bowls Wellington Board for ratification
