Nominations can take any form but should include a cover letter and supporting documentation. The more thorough the nomination, the more convincing it is likely to be.

The criteria for the respective awards and the nomination process can be found below.

Club of the Year

The Bowls Wellington Club of the Year recognizes a club demonstrating exceptional governance and operational management. Performance will be assessed against criteria in the following categories;

Governance and management practice
Financial management
Strategic Planning
Alignment with Bowls Wellington and Bowls NZ
Involvement in Centre events
Community engagement
New growth and development initiatives
Good media relations
Inclusivity and diversity

Nominations

Any club may nominate themselves. Please provide detailed evidence of the above and any other supporting documents. Note: this is different from *Champion Club of the Year*, which is decided by 'on the green' achievement.

Official of the Year

The Bowls Wellington Official of the Year recognizes an individual's exceptional success in officiating, either as an umpire, tournament controller or in another relevant official capacity. The nominee must be a member of a Wellington Bowling club.

Nominations

Clubs, individuals and associations are invited to put forward nominations. Please provide evidence and/or supporting documentation.

Administrator of the Year

The Administrator of the Year recognizes those that have made an outstanding contribution to their club, centre, or the game in an administrative capacity. They may be in a volunteer or paid role. They will be assessed against criteria including:

- Outstanding achievement and success in the role
- Length of service
- Commitment and dedication to the club/ centre/ sport.
- Communication and organizational skills

Nomination

Clubs, individuals and associations are invited to put forward nominations. Please provide evidence and/or supporting documentation.

Coach of the Year

The Coach of the Year recognizes the outstanding success of a coach delivering in the Wellington region. The coach must hold some level of Bowls NZ coaching qualification but can be delivering at any level of the game. Nominees will be assessed on their success in coaching and development of players and contribution to the game.

Nomination

Clubs, individuals and associations are invited to put forward nominations. Please provide evidence and/or supporting documentation.

Greenkeeper of the Year

Greenkeeper of the Year recognizes the invaluable work our greenkeepers do in maintain bowling greens through Wellington. They will be assessed on the following criteria:

Contribution to greenkeeping in Wellington
Involvement in the Greenkeeping Association
Quality of surfaces they produce
Commitment to further study and seeking knowledge
