# TO BE PLAYED UNDER THE LAWS of the SPORT of BOWLS and BOWLS NZ REGULATION 10

# **Conditions of Play**

Singles 21 Shots up Pairs 18 ends Fours 15 ends

Time limit of 2 hours 45 minutes in all games

In a time limit game if the jack has been delivered before the time signal, the end continues and if it is subsequently made dead it should be replayed until it is completed.

Ends made dead shall be replayed in accordance with Law 31 of the Laws of the Sport

# **Scoring**

2 points for each game won, 1 point for a draw.

The winner will be decided by:

- 1) The highest number of game points
- 2) If game points are equal then the side with the highest differential, if still equal the side with the lowest total shots against will be the winner.

## **Restricting the Movement of Players**

In time limit games the movement of players shall be restricted as follows:

After delivering their first bowl, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances.

Singles	The opponents after delivery of their 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> bowls
Pairs	<ul> <li>a) Leads after delivery of their 2<sup>nd</sup> &amp; 3<sup>rd</sup> bowls</li> <li>b) Skips after delivery of each of their bowls</li> </ul>
Fours	<ul> <li>a) Leads after the 2<sup>nd</sup> in their team has delivered both bowls</li> <li>b) Twos after the delivery of their 2<sup>nd</sup> bowl</li> <li>c) Threes after delivery of their 2<sup>nd</sup> bowl</li> <li>d) Skips after delivery of each of their bowls</li> </ul>

In exceptional and limited circumstances a Skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described above

If a player does not meet the terms of this law, Law 35 of The Laws of The Sport shall apply.

In the event of inclement weather or other extraordinary circumstances the Tournament Director may vary the conditions by reducing the number of ends and / or limiting the time of any game, or reducing the number of games but any decision Must be made before the commencement of a game otherwise Law 50 of the Laws of the Sport shall apply.
